Responsibilities

- Assessment of the impacts of political, legal and technological framework conditions and its changes on livestock production in Germany
- Farm-level accompanying research of science and technology research projects
- Analysis of sustainability aspects in livestock production systems
- International comparative analysis (international competitiveness, legal framework conditions)
- Active participation in the international network agri benchmark
- Cost-benefit analyses on various topics (mainly short-term requests from the Ministry)
- Elaboration of policy recommendations from the scientific results
- Preparation of reports and statements; publication of the results in national and international journals

Professional requirements

- University degree in agricultural science (focus on economic and social aspects of agriculture, agricultural economics or agribusiness) or economics
- PHD or comparable scientific qualification desired
- Well-grounded micro-economic proficiency, familiarity in the use of quantitative and qualitative analysis methods
- Experience in farm-level analysis, profound knowledge of the production system context, in particular in pig, poultry and beef production
- Experience in the editing of research reports, scientific publications and presentations
- Experience in acquisition of third-party funds and implementation / management of national / international research projects is advantageous
