


What is agri benchmark?

- What drives global agriculture and where production is heading to.
- Combine a "down-to-earth-approach" of typical farms with product specific expertise in sectors, markets and trade.
- Expertise is based on the cooperation of international scientific partners and their domestic advisors and growers.
- Principles: Independent, non-political, non-profit
- <u>Coordination:</u> von Thünen Institute (German Federal Research Institute) and DLG (German Agricultural Society)
- Funding: vTI, & industry partnerships & research projects

What is a **Typical Farm**


A typical farm...

- represents the origin of a major share of the national output in a given crop
- ⇒ can not be identified with an existing farm
- ⇒ is defined by a certain production system and a combination (if any) of enterprises
- ⇒ has certain structural features re. ownership of land as well as labor organization (family vs. hired)

A **standard operating procedure (SOP)** to define typical farms was developed and is used by all partners involved.


